

Sec. 410. TRAVEL ON ANY COMMON CARRIER FOR CERTAIN INTELLIGENCE PERSONNEL

PROPOSED TEXT:

- (a) DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY—Section 116(b) of the National Security Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 404k(b)) is amended by inserting before the period the following: “, who may redelegate such functions”.

SECTIONAL ANALYSIS:

Section 116(b) of the National Security Act allows the Director of National Intelligence to authorize travel on common carriers for certain intelligence collection personnel, and it further allows the DNI to delegate this authority to the Principal Deputy Director of National Intelligence or to the Director the Central Intelligence Agency. This provision permits the Director of the CIA to re-delegate this authority.
